An interpretation of the bid invitation documents will be made only by addendum duly issued to each person receiving a bid invitation and/or holding plans. The City of New Britain will not be responsible for explanations or interpretations of bid invitation documents except as issued in accordance herewith. Award will be made to the lowest responsible qualified Bidder, who shall be determined in accordance with and pursuant to Section 2-578, inclusive of the Purchasing Ordinances City of New Britain.
